- Students from partner universities must be nominated by their home universities via knusummer@knu.ac.kr before submitting the online application.

- Students from non-partner universities must send their 'Name/Nationality/Institution Name' directly to knusummer@knu.ac.kr.

- Applicants will receive an ID and PASSWORD with the link to access the online application website right after the nomination.

- Complete the payment.

- Submit the online application and upload a copy of the program fee payment receipt by December 13, 2023.

- All admitted students will receive program guidelines and methods of participation via email in early January.
