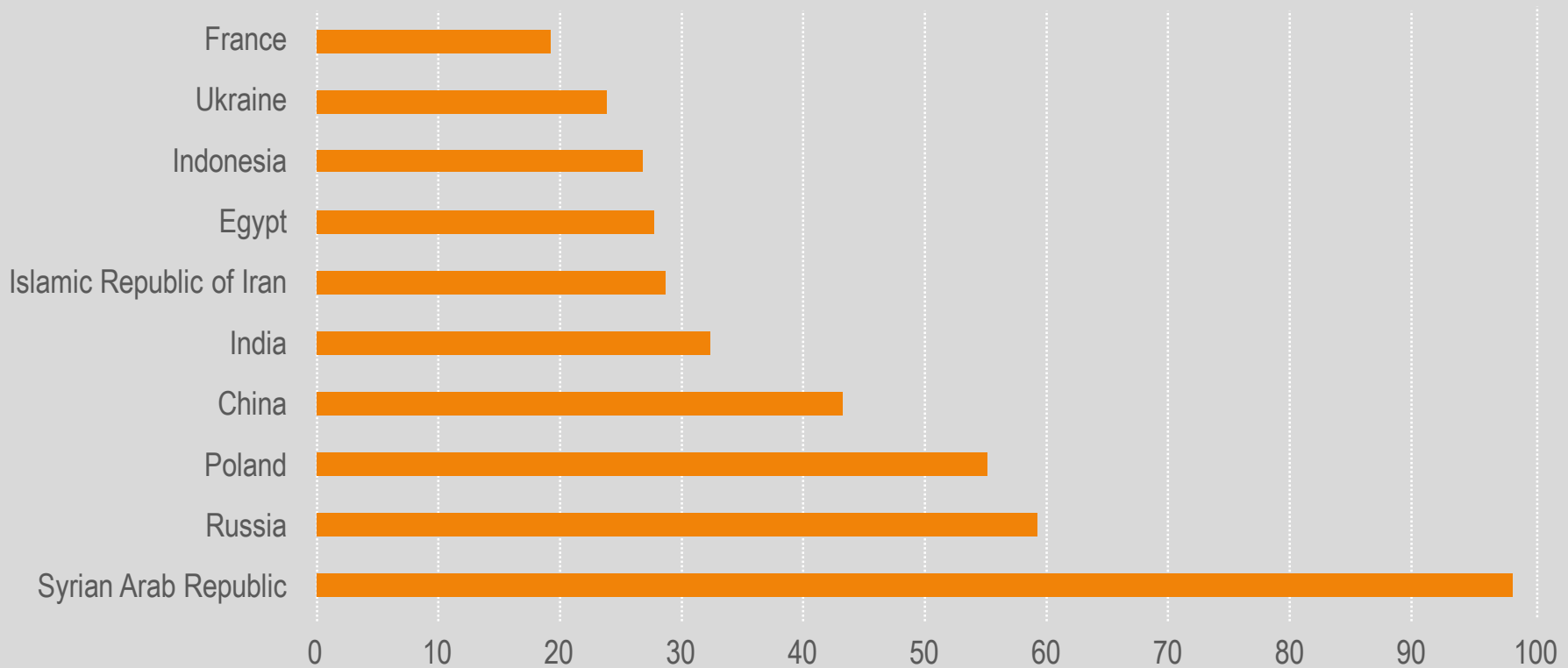

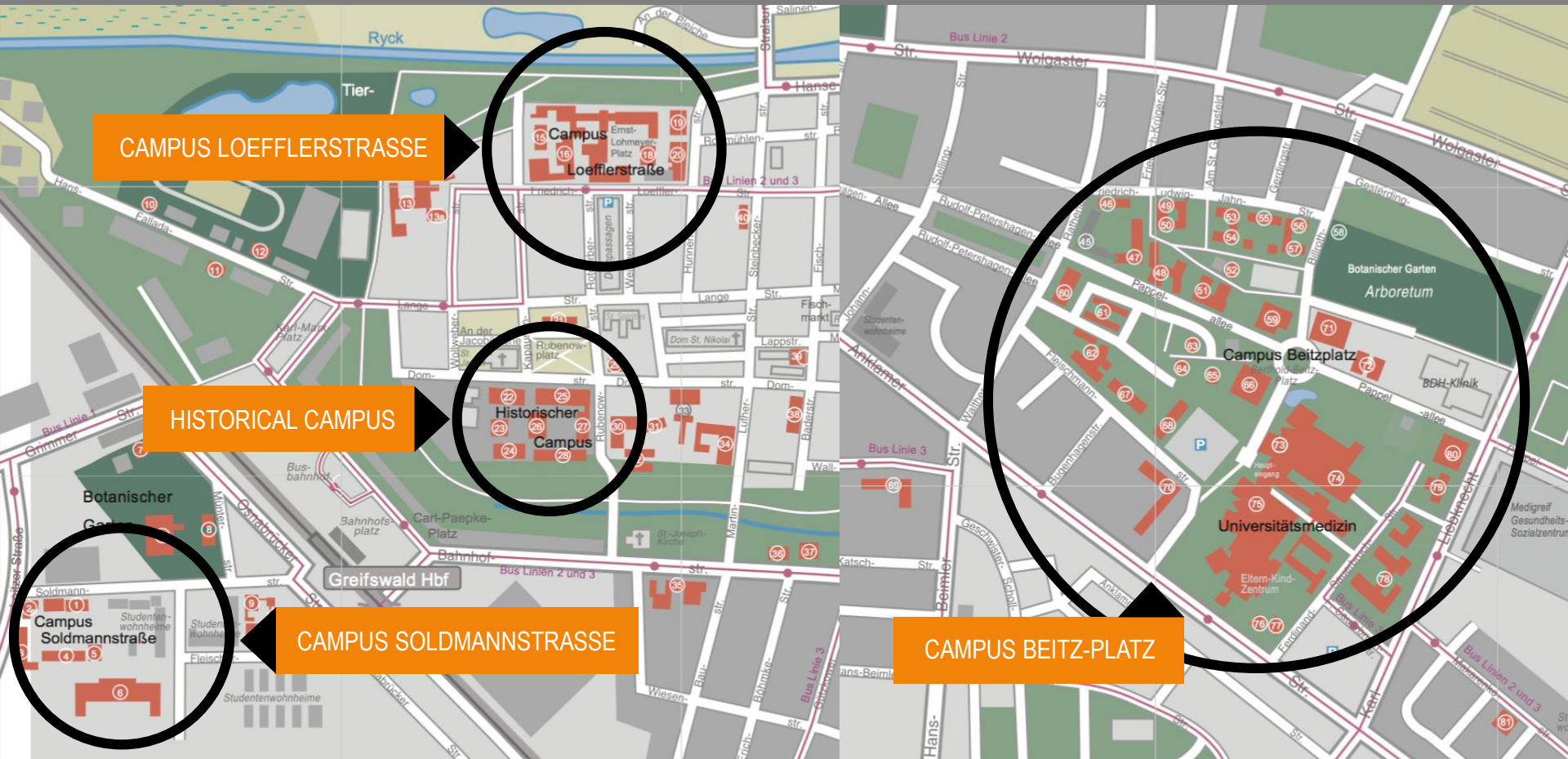

GETTING STARTED IN TOWN

Find accommodation

- ✓ In your welcome letter we have given you lots of tips and information on finding accommodation, including links. Use them!

Register at the Bürgeramt

- ✓ You can register at the Bürgeramt (at the Markt) within 2 weeks with your accommodation provider's certificate, certificate of enrolment and passport.
- ✓ Immediately after registering, you will receive a **certificate of registration**.
- ✓ Approximately 2 weeks later, you will receive your **tax identification number** by post - be sure to keep it!

To open a bank account

- ✓ To pay rent and insurance, you usually need a German bank account.
- ✓ You will need your passport, certificate of enrolment, **registration certificate** and **tax ID** (can often be submitted later)
- ✓ A current account for students is usually free of charge

Take out health insurance

- ✓ Health insurance is compulsory
- ✓ You will need your passport, certificate of enrolment, **registration certificate**, biometric photo and a bank account with IBAN number.

USER ACCOUNT

Access for almost everything

- ✓ E-mail account, HIS/LSF, Moodle, Eduroam WLAN, use of computers in the libraries, WLAN in halls of residence, etc.
- ✓ Comes with with certificate of enrolment
- ✓ First change your password at <https://ums.uni-greifswald.de>
- ✓ Account is not activated until you change your password!
- ✓ Password can be changed at the earliest 3 days after transferring the semester contribution -> if this is not possible, please contact the Registrar's Office to enquire about receipt of payment.

Regulations regarding On-Site Classes and examinations

- ✓ chequerboard seating plan for classes and examinations that take place on site (a gap of one seat between participants)
- ✓ only persons who are fully vaccinated, have been tested, or have recovered from an infection with COVID-19 are permitted entry to classes and examinations being held on site

Collection of Data

- ✓ The contact details of all participants must be collected for all classes/events (through student and staff ID cards). The primary means for collecting the data shall be the digital [COVID-19 Registration System](#) provided by the Computer Centre.

COVID-19

Testing Strategies

- ✓ If not vaccinated or recovered a test (SARS-CoV-2 antigen self or rapid test (AG) or PCR) is necessary prior to attending a class or examination being held on site
- ✓ 48 hours prior to the start of the on-site class/event
- ✓ 2 x per calendar week (optimally on Monday and Wednesday)
- ✓ in test centres or self-test at home
- ✓ the University provides self-tests free of charge until 15 November 2021: the appropriate chair/lecturer or Dean's Office organises the distribution of the self-tests
- ✓ [Self-Test Affirmation](#) shall be provided by the student

Psychological counselling

- ✓ In addition to social counselling (e.g. on organising/financing studies, studying with children), the Studierendenwerk also offers psychological counselling by psychologist Mr Løbke.

I explicitly consent to the University's temporary storage of the data I provided above confirming I am fully vaccinated against the coronavirus, have recovered from an infection with COVID-19, or have received a negative test result, for the purpose of digital access control via the student or staff ID card. The details of the coronavirus vaccination will be stored for no longer than the vaccination certificate is valid. This applies correspondingly to the proof of recovery from a COVID-19 infection and for the proof of a negative test result. The data will not be made available to third parties. All the details are voluntary, they can be removed at any time via deletion in the user account. Furthermore, the data will be deleted automatically as soon as the 3G status is no longer valid.
